



FIND FUNKY FUMES? TRY YOUR TRAP!

Does it seem like sewer gas is seeping into your shack?

Stop the smell with a simple check of your basement water trap.

Traps are often found under floor drains, laundry tubs, wash basins or other basement drains. When they dry out due to lack of use, sewer gas has easy access to the room, causing smells in the basement and beyond. A pitcher full of water can restore the trap and eliminate the smell.

In some instances, a missing cleanout plug could be allowing smells to flow around

the water trap. Sometimes the trap could have evaporated if not used for an extended period.

In both cases, the fix is easy as a replacement plug can be found at any hardware store. The same is true to a wax toilet ring seal, the absence of which can also be a source of smell.

In addition to getting rid of the stinky smell, taking these steps to eliminate the hydrogen sulfide gas is also in the best interest of those living in the home, as it can have side effects over time.
