GOING YARD: WASTE COLLECTION UNDERWAY

The collection of yard waste resumed March 28, a sure sign that warmer days are ahead. Yard waste will be picked up on regularly scheduled trash pickup days.

Residents should place yard waste curbside in a green-top cart or biodegradable paper bags. Dirt, stones, litter and other debris should be removed. Leaves and lawn trimmings in plastic bags will not be collected. **No sticker is necessary during the yard waste collection season.** To order a green top yard waste cart contact Customer Service at 724-776-4806, option 3.

Acceptable Yard Waste

Plant material such as leaves, grass clippings, small branches under four inches in diameter, brush, plants, house plants, flowers, roots, shrubbery, hedge trimmings, tree trimmings, sawdust, and similar debris commonly found in the course of maintaining yards.

NOT Acceptable Yard Waste

Food waste, fruits and vegetables, tree limbs over four inches in diameter, tree stumps, firewood, soil, sod, dirt, lumber, construction material, plastic bags, children's plastic toys, garden hoses, plastic flower pots, scrap metal, auto parts, motor oil, tires, rocks, bricks, stones or concrete chunks, excrement, and synthetic material.

COLLECTION CONNECTION RATES CHANGE

Several new Township rates went into effect April 1, including adjustments to Collection Connection Trash Stickers.

Small Item/Garbage Bag Stickers are now \$1, with Bulk/Large Item Stickers costing \$5.


