



## TOUGH TALK ON TURKEY THIS THANKSGIVING

As plans for Thanksgiving meals are being made, don't let backups and clogs caused by grease be one of the unwelcome guests in the home.

Whether the turkey is deep fried or roasted in the oven, fats and grease still accumulate through the cooking process.

And while garbage disposals grind solid material into smaller pieces, they do not prevent fats, oils, and grease (FOG) from flowing down the drain. And grease dissolving detergents can move those elements through household plumbing and cause buildups further down the line.

Over time, this FOG makes the pipe's interior smaller, which can cause a messy sewer backup in the home, which is both costly and disruptive.

Here are some tips to make sure the day remains one of giving thanks instead of backed up drains:

- Pour grease into an empty, heat-safe container or can and store it in the freezer. After it solidifies, throw it in the garbage.
- Dispose of scraps in the trash rather than through a garbage disposal.
- Use kitchen waste bins to discard lards/shortening, butter/margarine, food scraps, dairy products, batter and icing, salad dressings and sauces.
- Do not pour deep-fryer oil on the ground or down a storm drain as it could pollute waterways and clog storm pipes.
