



CARING FOR THE CARDBOARD COMPACTOR

It's one of the most-used services in the Township, and it takes more than regular maintenance to keep it running smoothly. That's where you come in.

The Township's commercial-strength cardboard compactor is capable of handling large volumes of cardboard carton waste. Located at the Municipal Center, the always popular, self-service machine is intended for resident use only.

The machine was recently refurbished and moved to a new location with a dedicated driveway – making now the perfect time to revisit the rules of use.

- **Don't leave boxes on ground. Wet or piled-up boxes can leave a mess. Please put all boxes inside the compactor.**
- **Break down boxes before compacting. Insert flat pieces of cardboard/flattened boxes into open slot.**
- **The compactor is for cardboard only. NO trash. NO styrofoam. NO packing peanuts. NO packing materials.**
- **Press the green button after loading cardboard to start compaction.**

YARD WASTE COLLECTION ENDS

Yard waste collections will end the week of December 12-16.

Place yard waste curbside in the green top cart or in biodegradable paper bags. Remove dirt, stones, litter, and other debris from the leaves. Close the bags by folding them top down. Leaves in plastic bags will NOT be collected.

No sticker is necessary during the yard waste collection season.

There will be no delay in trash collection the weeks of Christmas and New Years as they fall on the weekend.


