One-Time Credit Offered for Pool Filling

It's time to pull back the tarp and grab the bug skimmer to get swimming pools ready for the summer.

The Township offers a one-time credit for the filling of pools to make those summer days a little more relaxing.

Property owners must supply dates of the service. The Township will review water usage and the credit will be limited to 50 percent of the current sewer rates. Credit requests must be submitted for the current year only.

The credit is only available to pools issued with Cranberry Township Permits and an issued Certificate of Compliance.

Customers with a deduct meter are not eligible for this pool credit. It can take up to two billing cycles for the credit to appear on an account.
