What is the Township doing to address resident issues?

A full-time staff member has been devoted to focus entirely on these projects. These yard signs will be installed in neighborhood entrances where companies are working or will be working to ensure residents are aware. Additional information can be found by scanning the QR code below.

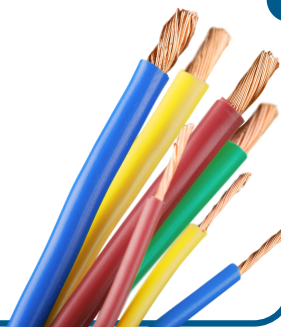


Why can't companies share lines or use existing lines?

Each company must use their own lines to ensure oversight and accountability in the future. Similarly, any existing lines are already owned by a specific company. Those lines may not be equipped to handle additional usage, requiring new lines to be installed.

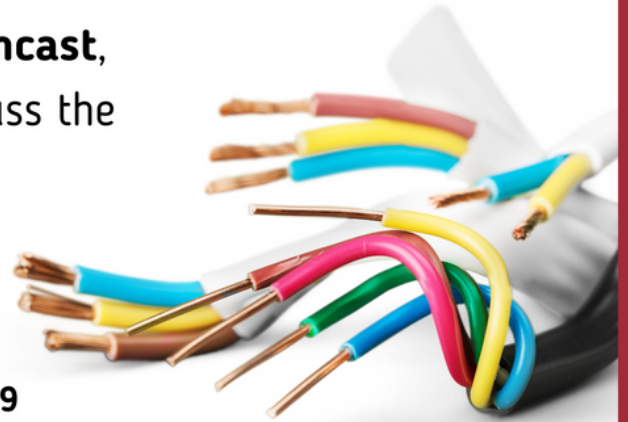
