

THE 411 ON TIPS FOR CARBON MONOXIDE SAFETY



Low winter temperatures make it a challenge to keep homes comfortable.

Some heating sources can pose dangers if used incorrectly. Keep in mind these tips for avoiding potentially deadly situations this winter.

- Avoid using alternative heating sources such as portable generators, kerosene heaters, propane gas stoves, and ovens heated with gasoline indoors as they can lead to carbon monoxide poisoning.
- Don't use a generator, charcoal grill, camp stove, or other gasoline or charcoal-burning device inside your home, basement, garage, or near a window.
- Don't run a car or truck inside an attached garage, even with the door open.
- Don't burn items in a stove or fireplace that aren't properly ventilated.
- Don't heat a house with a gas oven.
- Don't place a portable heater within reach of children or pets and don't use a power strip or extension cord to power it. Follow product instructions before use.
- Install carbon monoxide detectors and replace batteries as required. If the detector sounds, leave the home immediately and dial 911.
- Seek immediate medical attention by calling 911 if experiencing symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning. Initial symptoms include headache, nausea, vomiting, and fatigue. If recognized early, carbon monoxide poisoning is treatable.
