

KEEP IT CLEAR

TOWNSHIP GUIDELINES REGARDING SNOW REMOVAL

The Township's Public Works Department is always ready when winter weather hits. But to ensure a quick and effective response, residents are asked to take these steps to ensure the safety of Township crews and the community alike.

- Do not park on Township streets. Vehicles may be ticketed and/towed where there is no street parking signage.
- Follow the 10-foot rule: Keep basketball hoops, snow forts, parked cars in driveways, and non-permanent seasonal items 10 feet from the edge of the street.
- Do not move snow from driveways and sidewalks into the paved street.
- Trim trees so that branches do not extend beyond the back of the curb and a minimum of 14 feet in height.



SNOW, ICE, AND EVERYTHING (NOT SO) NICE

Avoid travel if possible during a snow event so crews can efficiently clear roads.

Please keep roadways clear of parked vehicles for emergency access, snow removal, and trash collection. Also, please keep sidewalks clear of snow & ice within 48 hours of the snow event.
