## SEASONAL GROUNDSKEEPERS SOUGHT

Cranberry Township's workforce is a well-oiled machine.

And the additive that keeps that machine running are the dozens of seasonal employees who not only keep the Township functioning but who give back to the community.



The Township is actively hiring short- and long-season employees to help keep Cranberry looking beautiful.

Long seasonal workers join the Township in March and work through November, while short seasonal workers join from May through August. They do everything from mowing and repairing athletic fields, maintaining restrooms, and caring for playgrounds and pavilions.

For some, it's finding something to do with the free time afforded by retirement or summer break from school. For others, it's about the chance to be outside tending to work that others may find tedious.

Seasonal employees join year-round staff to care for the Municipal Center, Fire Stations, Public Works Operations Center, neighborhood play lots, open green space, traffic islands, and building areas – as well as the Township's pristine parks. All told, the crew maintains more than 330 acres.



These seasonal opportunities are a great way for eager workers of all ages to make a few extra dollars while helping Cranberry offer the services residents have come to depend upon.
