

SAY YES! TO YARD WASTE

Cranberry Township's yard waste collection runs from April until early December on regular collection days.

Here are a few friendly reminders for how to properly dispose of grass and weeds this spring.

- Place yard waste curbside in a green top cart or biodegradable paper bags
- Remove dirt, stones, litter, and other debris
- Close bags by folding them top down
- No sticker is necessary during the yard waste collection season
- Leaves in plastic bags will NOT be collected

To order a green top yard waste cart, contact Customer Service at 724-776-4806 option 3. There is no additional fee for the yard waste cart.

Biodegradable Yard Waste bags are available for purchase from Customer Service. Five 30-gallon paper bags are available for \$2. Biodegradable paper bags are also available at most home improvement and hardware stores. Plastic lawn bags are not biodegradable.



Acceptable Yard Waste

Plant material such as leaves, grass clippings, small branches under four inches in diameter, brush, plants, house plants, flowers, roots, shrubbery, hedge trimmings, tree trimmings, sawdust, and similar debris commonly found while maintaining yards.

NOT Acceptable Yard Waste

Food waste, fruits and vegetables, tree limbs over four inches in diameter, tree stumps, firewood, soil, sod, dirt, lumber, construction material, plastic bags, children's plastic toys, garden hoses, plastic flowerpots, scrap metal, auto parts, motor oil, tires, rocks, bricks, stones or concrete chunks, excrement, and synthetic material.
