Giant Eagle Marks Corporate Move with Donation

Giant Eagle will formally become part of the Cranberry Township community on April 11, and corporate officials are wasting no time giving back to that community.

The company will celebrate the opening of its new corporate headquarters at 700 Cranberry Woods Drive during a ceremony at 10 a.m. Thursday, April 11.

At the ceremony, Giant Eagle will donate \$25,000 to Cranberry Township earmarked for the Powell Farm, a 71-acre property recently acquired by the Township to serve as an educational space for residents and educational institutions. The farm is a living, active monument to the Township's 200-year history in agriculture. Future uses will be determined by an Advisory Committee, which recently began meeting to consider possibilities.

Cranberry Township officials will be on hand to welcome Giant Eagle to the community.
