Public Works Department Working Hard This Winter

The Township's Public Works Department is always ready when winter weather hits. But they need your help to work as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Taking these steps ensure the safety of Township crews and residents and will help keep streets safe and passable.

- ✿ Do not park on Township streets. Vehicles may be ticketed and/towed where there is no street parking signage.
- ✿ Follow the 10-foot rule: Keep basketball hoops, snow forts, parked cars in driveways, and non-permanent seasonal items 10 feet from the edge of the street.
- ✿ Do not move snow from driveways and sidewalks into the paved street.
- ✿ Trim trees so that branches do not extend beyond the back of the curb and a minimum of 14 feet in height.

The Scoop On Snow Removal

Avoid travel if possible during a snow event so crews can efficiently clear roads. Keep sidewalks clear within 48 hours of the snow event.
