



## Credits for Leaks and Pools MADE CRYSTAL CLEAR

Cranberry Township offers credit for filling pools to make those summer days more relaxing.

Property owners must supply the dates of the activity. The Township will review water usage, and the credit will be limited to 50 percent of the current sewer rates. Credit requests must be submitted for the current year only.

The credit is only available to pools issued with Cranberry Township Permits and an issued Certificate of Compliance. Customers with a deduct meter are not eligible for this pool credit. The credit can take up to two billing cycles to appear on an account.

To submit information to receive a credit, scan the QR code.

The one-time credit is part of a Township policy that includes guidance on concealed leaks.

The policy is based on the concept that once water passes through a meter and enters a home, it is considered treated and delivered for use. Charges for water and sewer services apply since the system treats and provides the water and must also treat the resulting wastewater.

This includes water that goes into the sewer system due to a leak, meaning refunds are unavailable for concealed leaks.
