Simple Summer Steps For Securing Significant Savings

There's no shortage of ways to save money and energy as the summer sets in. Here are a few tips to stay cool while also being conscious of energy usage.

- Maintain or upgrade HVAC systems - clean HVAC filters, check ventilation, and schedule a tune-up
- Seal windows and doors to prevent cool air from escaping and hot air from entering
- Consider a programmable thermostat or monitor settings
- Ensure that furniture or other objects do not block air vents, allowing cooling system to operate at peak efficiency
- Unplug unused electronics and turn off lights when not in use
- Keep curtains and blinds closed during the hottest parts of the day to reduce indoor temperatures by blocking out direct sunlight
- Limit oven use and instead opt for stovetop cooking, grilling outside, or preparing no-cook meals
- Open windows during cooler parts of the day to allow fresh air to circulate
- Use strategically placed ceiling fans and set fans to spin counterclockwise for a refreshing breeze
- Wash full loads of laundry and dishes and avoid running during on-peak hours (between 6-8 p.m.) or on hot summer days
- Take shorter showers and lower the water heater temperature to 120 degrees
- Look for efficient appliances and lighting options
- Use exhaust fans in kitchens and bathrooms to reduce humidity
- Keep garage doors closed
- If rooms aren't in use, close the doors to keep cool air from circulating into those spaces
