



Clean, Clear Celebrations

Trees, lights, and ornaments shouldn't be the only things sparkling this holiday season! Here's a helpful guide on what holiday items should be recycled.

Wrapping Paper

Thin paper full of color, glitter or other embellishments should not be recycled. However, thin, non-colored cardboard-type wrapping paper can be recycled, along with tubes from inside the paper.

Gift Bags

Brown bags can be recycled if the handles are removed. Bags that are colored, glittered, shiny, or have embellishments should not be recycled.

Bows and Ribbons

Ribbon will get caught in equipment and should not be recycled.

Cards

Plastic cards covered in glitter or containing embellishments should not be recycled. Plain paper cards may be recycled.

Christmas Lights

Christmas lights are considered tangles and will get caught in recycling equipment and should not be recycled.

Gift Boxes

Cardboard boxes should be empty and broken down to fit in a trash receptacle or can be transported to the Cardboard Compactor at the rear of the Municipal Center.

Foam Packaging

Foam packing peanuts cannot be recycled and should be discarded in the trash.

Old or Broken Ornaments

Whether glass, plastic, or some other material, these items should be discarded in the trash.

Holiday Plants

Potted plants, cut flowers, and wreaths should be composted without their pots, foam, or frames.

Batteries

Used or expired batteries should not be placed in trash or recycling. Many stores offer battery recycling options.

Trees

Leave trees with your trash during the first two weeks of January.

Holiday Trash Pickup Set

With Christmas and New Year's Day occurring on weekdays, collection dates will be held a day later than normal.

Do Not Knock List Open

Limit the number of times you ask, "Who's there?" by enrolling in the Township's Do Not Knock list.

By registering each year, residents can choose not to have door-to-door sales of goods, commodities, or services at their homes.

The list is purged each year on December 31, so residents who previously were on the list must register again.
