



**The new year is a perfect time to make a change or two – and why not make a change that can impact your bottom line? Below are a few tips to improve utility usage and save money in the process.**

#### **Energy Saving Tips**

- Pay attention to the thermostat. Every degree you raise or lower the temperature could impact energy costs by up to 3%.
- Keep furnaces and ducts clean to ensure efficient operation.
- Adding insulation, installing storm windows and doors, and sealing cracks and air leaks can improve efficiency.
- Check hot water heaters. Temperatures over 120 degrees can be a major power drain.
- Run full loads to reduce the use of hot water and limit the amount of energy needed to heat it.
- Open curtain windows during the day to allow sunlight to naturally heat the home and close them at night to reduce the chill.
- Use heavy-duty plastic on the inside of window frames to reduce drafts.

#### **Water Saving Tips**

- Install low-flow fixtures. These can achieve savings of 25-60%.
- Fix leaks. A leak of one drip per second wastes 1,661 gallons of water and can cost up to \$35 per year.
- Choose energy efficiency. The biggest cost of washing dishes and clothes comes from the energy required to heat the water.
- Consume less energy and use less water by running a dishwasher with a full load instead of hand-washing.
- Using cold water for clothes washing reduces energy use. Older, less efficient machines cost three times as much to operate as energy efficient ones. Additionally, front-loading machines use less water than top loaders.

## **Do Not Knock List Open**

Limit the number of times you ask, "Who's there?" by enrolling in the Township's Do Not Knock list.

By registering each year, residents can choose not to have door-to-door sales of goods, commodities, or services at their homes.

The list is purged each year on December 31, so residents who previously were on the list must register again.
