Flushing to Begin in April

Water going down the drain over the next few months is actually helping keep Cranberry's water supply flowing cleanly.

Hydrant flushing is a routine maintenance operation designed to flush sediment from the water system, check fire hydrant operation, and test chlorine levels in the water lines throughout the Township.

Flushing is conducted from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Discolored water and fluctuations in water pressure are normal during flushing.

The Township suggests that customers refrain from doing laundry when their neighborhood lines are being flushed.

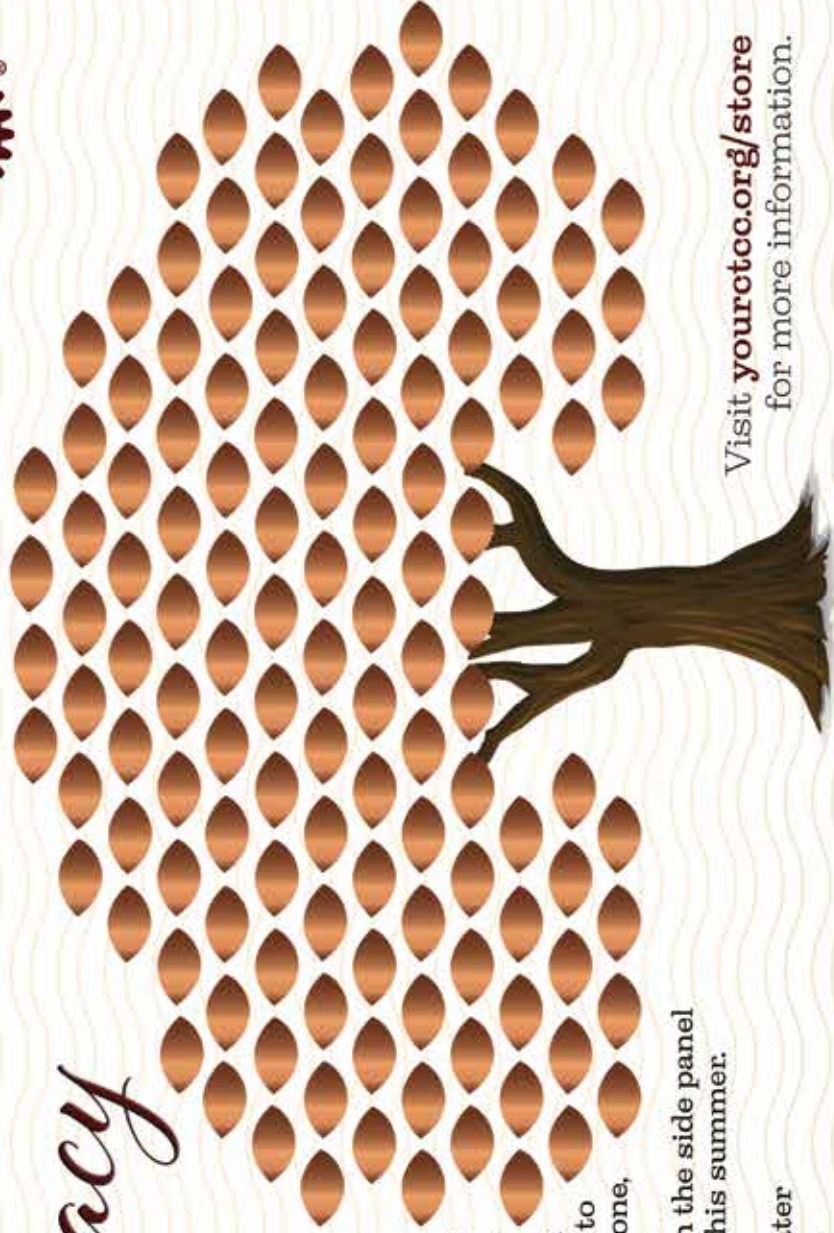
