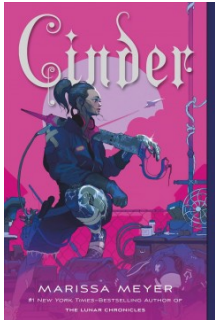


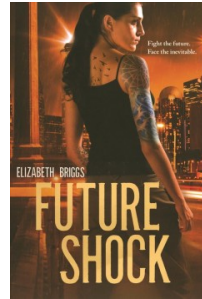

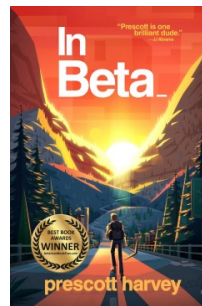
Future shock

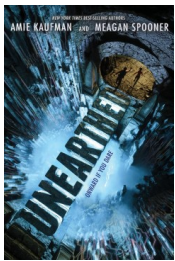
The final six

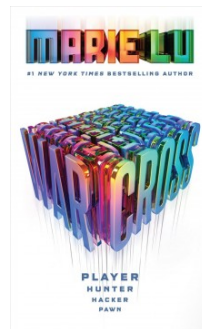
In beta

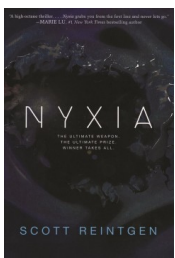
Unearthed
