### PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Customers are billed monthly, as part of the Sewer, Water and Trash bill.
- Variable base rates are linked to the volume of household garbage generated. (The larger the grey-top trash cart, the higher the base rate.)
- Recycling (blue-top cart) and yard waste (green-top cart) are collected at no additional cost.
- A prepaid collection sticker system is used to discard extra items.

### HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

If one of the holidays below occurs on a WEEKDAY, there will be NO PICK UP on that day, and collection will be DELAYED BY ONE DAY for the remainder of the week: **New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas**

## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

MATERIAL	ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED	PREPARATION
<b>GLASS</b>	Clear, brown, amber and green glass bottles and food jars	Broken glass, light bulbs, dishes, drinking glasses, ceramics, mirrors, Pyrex or tempered glass	Rinse bottles and jars, Remove & discard lids. Do not break glass (labels may be left on).
<b>ALUMINUM, STEEL AND BI-METAL CANS</b>	Food and beverage cans	Aluminum foil, cans containing food, clothes hangers, scrap metal, screws, nails, toys, lawn furniture, paint cans, aluminum siding	Rinse cans (crush if space is needed) and push lid down inside of can.
<b>PLASTICS (PET, HDPE)</b> Stamped #1 through #6 bottom	Clear and green plastic soda bottles, milk and water jugs, liquid detergent, bleach and softener bottles, hair care bottles	Styrofoam peanuts and blocks, plastic plant pots, #7 plastic, foam plastic egg cartons, plastic wrap, bubble wrap, plastic bags (loose nor bundled), CD/DVD's, toys, lawn furniture, motor oil, cooking oil, herbicide, antifreeze	Discard lids and rinse container (crush if space is needed) (Lids are not recyclable, be sure to remove & discard in trash.)
<b>NEWSPRINT AND MAGAZINES</b>	Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, office and computer paper, phonebooks, wrapping paper, junk mail	Foil wrapping paper	Place loose in cart.
<b>CARDBOARD</b>	Clean corrugated, pressed cardboard cartons, boxes including, moving & shipping, paperboard boxes including tissue boxes	Pizza boxes, milk cartons, juice boxes, take-out food containers, oily, soiled, or contaminated cardboard	Flatten or break down into pieces no larger 4 feet. Remove all packing material including styrofoam blocks, peanuts, bubble wrap, etc.

### CARDBOARD COMPACTOR

A commercial-strength compactor, capable of handling large volumes of cardboard carton waste, is available for residential use behind the Cranberry Municipal Center.
