

If your desired program is full, a waitlist may be created. Participants on a waitlist will be added according to entry order and will be notified only if a space becomes available, or if a new session has been added.

Refund Policy

Contact Parks & Recreation Customer Service at 724-779-4FUN (4386) to withdraw or cancel a registration. Instructors are not authorized to issue refunds or credits.

Refunds: A refund will be issued if the Parks & Recreation Department is notified of the withdrawal at least 7 days in advance of the start date of the class or activity. Refunds are issued by check or credited to a credit card. A processing fee of \$5 is assessed for all cancelled registrations. No refunds issued after the program start date. **Please see the refund policy for each individual program for additional information.**
