Academy students will participate in real-life, hands-on activities such as operating lines, cutting a vehicle with the Jaws of Life, extinguishing live fires, performing simulated ladder rescues, forcible entries of doors, searching for victims, and climbing a ladder truck. This new Academy provides critical insight into volunteering for community.



ABOUT THE ACADEMY

The Cranberry Township Volunteer Fire Company has created an 8-week public education course to provide residents and Cranberry-based business owners with a free opportunity to learn how the fire company operates. Volunteer firefighters will teach each session, covering topics such as apparatus types and functions, working in turnout gear, forcible entry, ladders, hose line advancement, and vehicle extrication.

Course culminates with a live-burn dynamics demonstration. Graduates will leave with a better understanding of the Fire Company via hands-on sessions and student skill stations, plus a new awareness of the importance of volunteering for community.
