


# Signing up for a CTPA Membership Waitlist

**Reminder:** Signing up for the CTPA Membership Waitlist does not guarantee a membership for the upcoming year. Current members will have the ability to renew from November to the end of the current year, this will then determine how many New Members we are able to offer memberships to.

First, anyone looking to register to the New Member Waitlist will have to create a Court Reserve Account. Use this link here to access **CTPA's Court Reserve page:**

On the Court Reserve page you will see “**Create Account**” in the top right corner, select that and you will be taken to a page to input all of your information.

Once you have entered all your information and created your account, you will now be able to register to the waitlist for 2026. In the top right corner next to your name you will see a button that says **“Join Organization”** select that and it will bring you to the memberships page where you can select to register to one of two memberships depending on your residency.



Select **“Join Waitlist”** on the waitlist that you should be on.
