Every badge completed gives you a virtual ticket for a chance to win a grand prize at the end of Summer Reading! Once you receive your Completion Badge, stop by the Children's Department for your board book and prize!



Children's Summer Reading Challenge

Create an online profile through Beanstack (or use the account created previously) and complete the Logging and Activity Badges at your own pace throughout the summer.

Record the time you spend reading and earn coupons to local establishments with each hourly Reading Reward!

Earn up to ten prizes through Reading Rewards!

Complete the Activity Badges to earn virtual raffle tickets for a chance to win a grand prize at the end of Summer Reading! Complete them all to win a book of your choice AND a bag of prizes!

Teen Summer Reading

Teens going into grades 6-12 can read whatever they want for Summer Reading. This includes magazines, website articles, books, audio books, podcasts ... anything!

To participate, teens will need to create a Summer Reading Challenge profile through Beanstack, (or use the account created previously) and then keep track of what and how long they read. As you read, make sure you track and log your reading online so you earn prizes! You can also earn and complete various Activity Badges to receive virtual raffle tickets for grand prizes to be awarded at the end of Summer Reading.

The last day to earn your prizes is August 1st!



Adult Summer Reading

Adults ages 18 and over can register online at cranberrytownship.beanstack.org for the Adult Summer Reading Program.

Earn Badges for reading and participating in various activities at the library. Badges earn you virtual tickets that you can put towards a chance to win prizes at the end of Summer Reading!

BEANSTACK for Summer Reading

What is Beanstack?

Beanstack is the library's web-based Summer Reading Program software. It allows you to track your reading minutes/activities and earn rewards.

How do I register?

1. Go to cranberrytownship.beanstack.org
2. If you participated in our past Summer or Winter Reading Programs, you can log in and get started using your previous username and password. Just remember to update your age and grade.
3. Click on the blue "Register an Individual or Family" button.
4. Fill in the information. If you are a parent registering a child, be sure to enter in your information under "Adult Information." Beanstack allows families to be linked together, so that all family members can be accessed with one login.
5. Once you are registered, you will be taken to your account page. This is where you will log your minutes, activities, and track the badges you earn!

How do I log minutes and activities?

1. Go to cranberrytownship.beanstack.org or download the Beanstack Tracker app for Android and iPhone.
2. Click on the blue "Log Reading and Activities" button in the upper left corner or on the blue plus sign in the app.
3. Follow the prompts on the screen to log whatever you've accomplished.

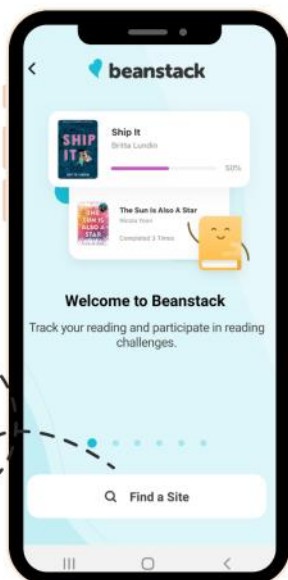

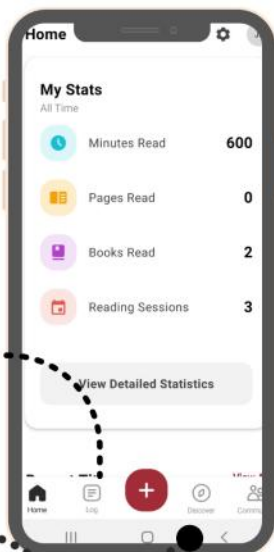

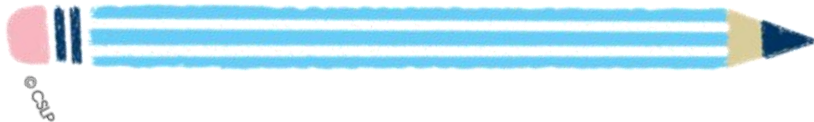

Children's Programs



Caregiver & Me Infant Playtime: Join us for 45 minutes of free play and family bonding time. Recommended for ages birth-18 months. Registration is required.

ABC Playtime: Join us for 45 minutes of free play and family bonding time. Recommended for children 19 months - 5 years. Registration is required.

Block Party: Block Party is a PA State Library STEAM initiative used to encourage the use of block play for developmental and learning growth in young children. Join us for a 45 minute free play session with wooden blocks and other fun building toys. Recommended for children ages 2-5 years. Registration is required.

Crafty Friday: Stop by the Children's Department most Fridays during Summer Reading for a simple craft from 11 am to 1 pm. All ages welcome; no registration required.

Movie Matinee: Join us on select Wednesdays during Summer Reading for a lunchtime movie. Bring a bagged lunch or snack and enjoy the show! All ages welcome. Registration is required.

Chalk the Garden: June 12th @ 2 PM ► Stop by the reading garden for an outdoor chalk doodle session. All ages welcome. Registration is preferred, but not required.

Playdough Playdate: June 12th @ 6 PM (Sensory Friendly Time @ 5:30)
Join us for an evening of free play with playdough. We provide the dough and tools. You provide the imagination! Recommended for children ages 3 to 9. Registration is required.

Kids Yoga with Ivy Rehab: June 18th, July 2nd, & July 16th @ 10:30am
Join us for a 30 minute class focusing on strength, flexibility, posture, and balance. This class will be led by a physical therapist who can assist the kids in yoga poses & breathing. Don't forget to bring your yoga mat!
Attendance is limited to children ages 5-10 years. Registration is required.
