# Storytimes

Our Storytimes are some of the library's most popular programs! They require advance registration. When you register, you will be signing up for a 4 week long session, and we ask that you attend all sessions. Why? Studies show that repetition is crucial in helping children become skillful and confident learners. When you register online, look for the first day of the session you want your child to attend.

## Infant Storytime

Join us for 20 minutes of books, songs, and rhymes, followed by music and bubbles. Recommended for ages birth - 18 months. *Online registration is required.*

## A-B-C Storytime

Children enjoy books, songs, rhymes, manipulatives and movement, and a craft kit to take home. Recommended for ages 19 months - preschool aged. *Online registration is required.*

# 1000 Books Before Kindergarten

Start your child off on the road to reading by joining our 1000 Books Before Kindergarten reading challenge! To register, go the Children's Program page on our website and click the link at the top. Log your books through the Beanstack app and stop by the library at each 100 book milestone to add your child's name to our milestone display. Read any book to your newborn, infant, toddler, or preschooler to count towards the 1000 books goal. Your child will earn stickers and lots of praise from the librarians as they move along their reading journey!

# Youth Programs

## Homeschool Cafternoon

For elementary-aged children. Stop by between 1pm-2pm and make a craft in the Children's Department on select Thursdays each month. Leave when you've finished the craft, or stay and hang out with other homeschoolers! *This is a drop-in program; no registration is required.*

For grades K-6th. Meets on select Tuesdays each month between 4pm-5pm. Join us at the tables out in the Children's Department for an hour of free building with other LEGO enthusiasts. Work on the challenge of the day and stay until 5pm, or leave when you're finished!

## **Caregiver and Me Infant Playtime**

Join us on select Fridays at either 10am or 11am for 45 minutes of free play and family bonding time.

*Recommended for ages birth - 18 months. Online registration is required.*

## **Block Party**

Block Party is a PA State Library STEAM initiative used to encourage the use of block play for developmental and learning growth in young children. Join us on select Fridays at either 10am or 11am for a 45 minute free play session with wooden blocks and other fun building toys.

*Recommended for ages 2-5 years. Online registration is required.*

## **Movie Matinee: Friday, January 16th @ 12pm**

Join us on select Fridays throughout the year for a special movie matinee. Bring a bagged lunch and enjoy the show!

*All ages welcome. Online registration is required.*

To sign up for programs:

1. Go to [www.cranberrylibrary.org](http://www.cranberrylibrary.org)
2. Find *Online Registration* under the Kids & Tweens or Teens Tab.
3. Find the program you want to register for, and click *View More Information*. From that page, click on *Register*.
4. Register as a guest.
5. **For Storytime, you DO need to register EACH child AND adult. Only one adult per family please. Storytimes are limited to 30 participants (adults & children).**
